



## Job specification/skills for the post of Science Teacher

4 reasons why you may wish to join our Meols Cop High School learning community:

- You will be expected to teach all three sciences at KS3 and KS4 and have expertise to challenge GCSE grade 9 students in all three disciplines. We begin our G.C.S.E. Combined Science and Triple Science courses (Edexcel) in Year 9 and have also incorporated many concepts into years 7 and 8.
