JOB TITLE: ISEND Engagement and Participation Officer

DEPARTMENT: Children's Services

RESPONSIBLE TO: Senior Manager: SEN Strategy & Engagement

Purpose of the Role:

To work within ISEND, Children's Services to develop and embed processes that enable the participation of children and young people and parent carers in decision-making and service planning, delivery and evaluation.

Key tasks:

- Promote and build a network of participation by developing and embedding a county-wide process that enables children and young people with SEND and their families to participate and make a meaningful contribution to the development of services
- 2. Coordinate opportunities between services, schools, health and social care and the voluntary sector, parent carers for children and young people with SEND to engage and participate in giving their views
- 3. Work with services, schools, health and social care and the voluntary sector, wider stakeholders and parent carers to identify children and young people with SEND to contribute and participate in giving views, feedback and developing their own voice
- 4. Designing and deliver consultation sessions with young people through the application of emerging digital innovation to ensure that their views feed into our services, policy and influencing work.
- 5. Use social media creatively to engage with and influence a younger audience. Apply a range of participation and engagement methodologies for both face to face and digital use.

- 6. Lead on ensuring that those working with children and young people with SEND are equipped with the right resources and training to support authentic participation in consultation, activities, feedback and developing their own voice
- 7. Develop participation opportunities with parent carers that facilitates effective engagement in the development of support and services
- 8. Play an active role in wider training opportunities, for example to council members or school governors to ensure that an ethos of participation is understood and practiced county-wide
- 9. Establish processes for reporting back findings at strategic level, as well as through communication channels such as social media
- 10. Act as champion for diversity and equality to ensure that protected characteristics of age, gender and gender orientation, sexual orientation, race, religion or belief, socio-economic status and disability are well-represented in children and young person's voice
- 11. Actively promote accessibility to ensure full representation is achieved
- 12. Work actively to promote an understanding of inclusive practices in the participation of children and young people that recognises the diversity of individuals and challenges under-representation and unconscious bias
- 13. Work co-operatively with other workers within Children's Services such as Youth Cabinet officer, and across other agency's youth groups such as Amazing Futures to help develop and share best practice in participation.
- 14. Encourage and foster a climate where children and young people are keen to become involved and are provided with a wide range of mechanisms and support to enable them to do so.
- 15. Engage in regional or national youth participation projects as required
- 16. To carry out the above duties clearly demonstrating an understanding of diversity and equality for the County Council and Children's Services
